## Rules About Essay Writing

1. The essay should be on the main theme or sub-themes discussed in the concept note.
2. The essay should be written in 900 to 1000 words. Non-adherence to word limits would lead to deduction of marks. Essays in less than 800 words would not be considered at all.
3. The essay should be in your own words, well documented, and plagiarism of any sorts would lead to disqualification.
4. All the references, if any, should be included inside the text of the essay itself.
5. The title should be written on the top of the essay.
6. The essay should be typed in TIMES NEW ROMAN with font size of 12. The line space should be 1.5 and text should be justified.
7. The essay should be paginated.
8. No other detail, (personal and professional) should be written in the body of the essay.

## Eligibility Criteria

The program is open for all the students of colleges and universities. It is divided into two sections—Senior section which comprises of students of PG programs and beyond; and junior section which includes the students of UG programs.
